Did you know that the word "hallelujah" comes from two Hebrew words: the first, "hallal", which means to boast, brag on, or celebrate; and the second, "jah", which is the shortened form of God. So whenever the word "Hallelujah" is spoken, you've just let the world know you are EXCITED about God! You are really saying, "Lord, I celebrate You!" Today's scripture says to make His praise glorious, and you don't have to keep quiet about it! Celebrations are usually noisy!
