Let the One who lives in you shine through you!

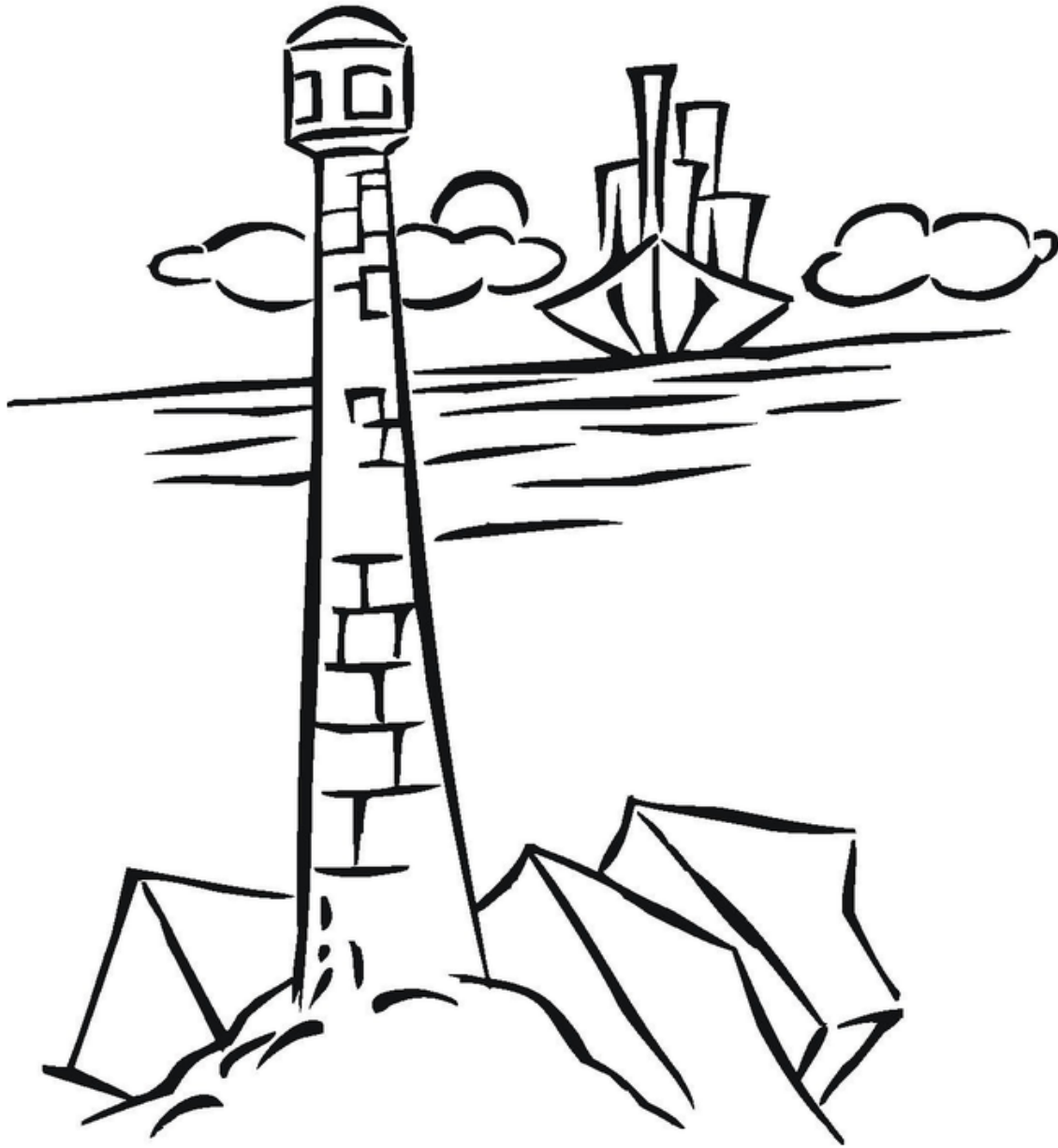
Pray
