“Living Sacrifices”

READ Romans 12:12

“Therefore, I urge you brother, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God – this is your spiritual act of worship. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is – His good and pleasing and perfect will.”

READ 2 Corinthians 7:1

“Since we have these promises, dear friends, let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God.”

READ Philippians 4:8

“And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise.”

What is a living sacrifice? This song does a great job explaining it. Long ago, the Israelites would place gifts to God on structures (altars); sometimes they were animal sacrifices. This is hard for us to understand because we don’t offer these kinds of sacrifices or offerings but..... We can actually offer ourselves as a LIVING SACRIFICE!!!! We can dedicate our lives to Christ and live for Him each moment of each day. In order to do this, we must first purify ourselves. What are some things that can trash our bodies and our spirits? We want to ask the Lord to cleanse us of anything wrong we have put in our bodies or allowed our spirits to take in: things like the wrong things to eat, watch, hear, see, etc. Always be mindful of what you are putting in your body for the Lord. Be a LIVING SACRIFICE for Him and cleanse yourself of those unclean things. Ask the Lord to forgive you of your sins and repent and seek Him in all you do.

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WHY TO MEMORIZE?

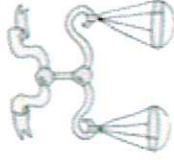
