Frances learned 7 languages and memorized the entire New Testament, the Psalms, Isaiah & many other Old Testament books. Can you think of another hymnist we studied who memorized much of the Bible and wrote many hymns even though she was blind? (Her name was Crosby.) These two incredible women (both named Frances!) spread the love of Jesus everywhere they went. Think of someone you know who doesn't know Jesus.
