READ Romans 8:35, 37-39

“Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or dangers or sword? ...No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither life death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, or anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us form the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

WHY TO MEMORIZE?

Psalms 119:11 (EVERYONE)

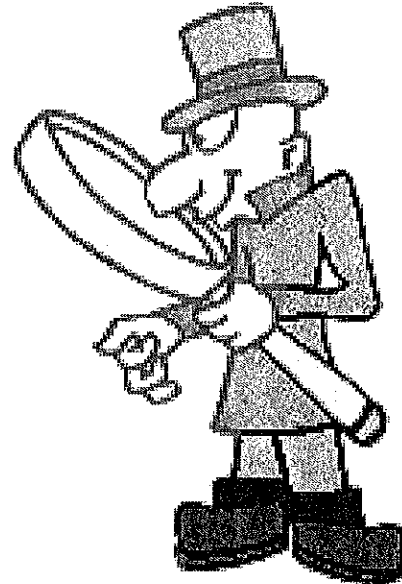

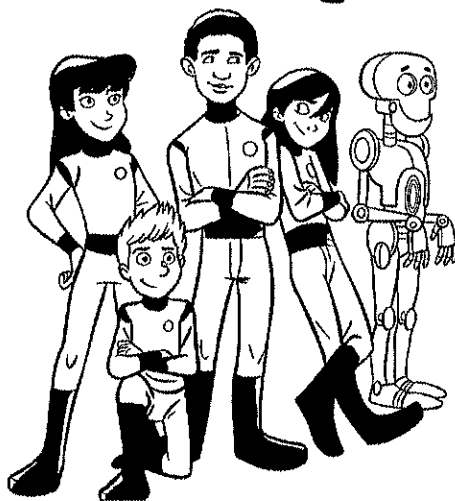
