“Forgive”

READ Colossians 3:12-15

“Therefore, as God’s chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity....Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body, you were called to peace. And be thankful.”

READ 1 Corinthians 13:4-8a

“Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast. It is not proud. It is not rude. It is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails!

How should we treat others? This verse tells us we are to be compassionate, kind, gentle, and more. We are to forgive others when they do wrong things to us, even when we don’t want to. All of these things are traits that Christ would have. We are to be like Christ in all that we do. The most important characteristic we can have like Christ is to LOVE. Our world portrays love in a very faulty view but let’s look at how God portrays love in this verse. It says love is “patient”. How is love patient? Maybe your brother did something mean to you, but you didn’t react in a mean way and were patient with them. Love is also kind. What are ways that love is kind? Maybe there is a kid that is lonely at school, you can be their friend or stick up for someone who is being bullied. Love is so many things in this verse. Take time to talk with your family about each thing and how we can express love in different ways. The Bible says that true love, which is found in Christ alone, never fails. This verse helps you recognize what real love is and how you can show others real love!

WHY TO MEMORIZE?

1. One of the most important reasons is that God uses scripture to speak to us. If we memorize them, then we can quickly bring them to our mind when we need them and He wants to say something to us.

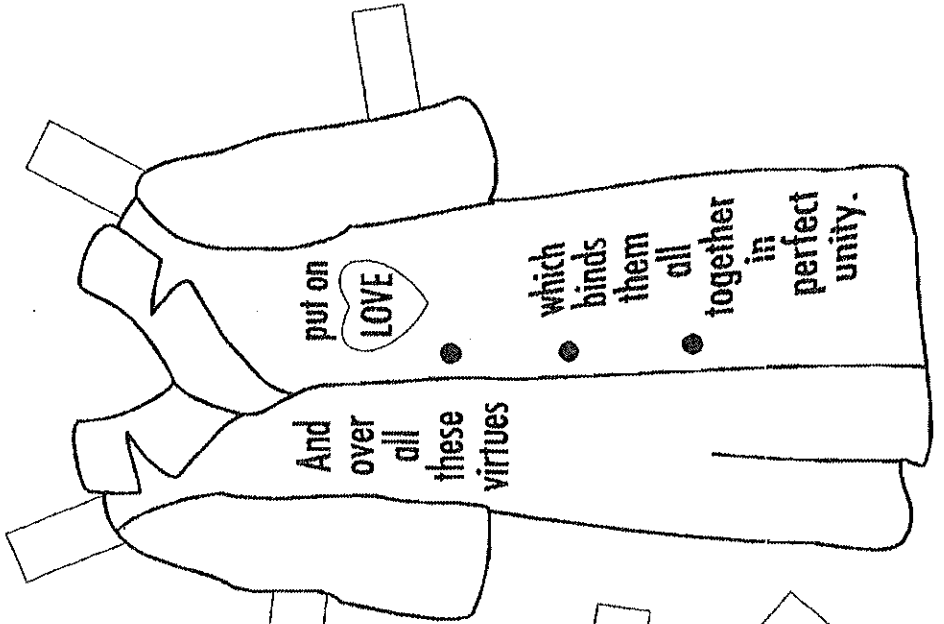
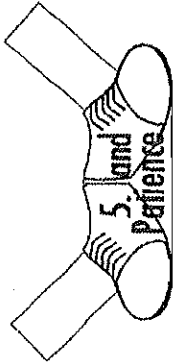
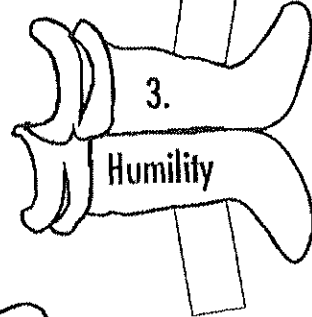
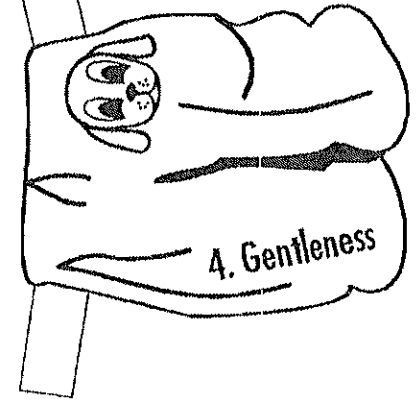
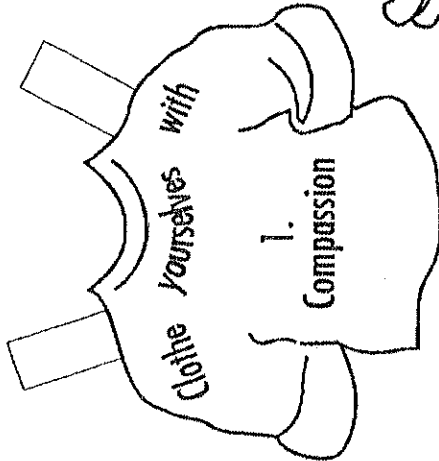
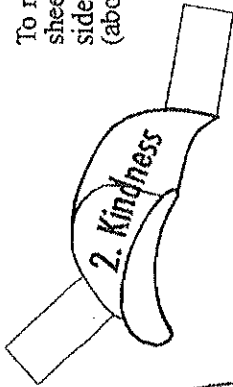
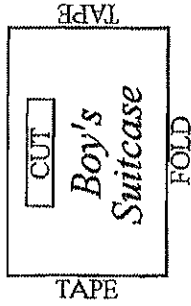
Is Not PROVOKED

"Clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity."

Color. Cut out boy and clothes. Dress boy as you say verse. Coat goes on last, covering clothing. An optional way to do this craft is to cut out clothes (except coat) without tabs, and glue them in place on boy. Cut out coat with tabs so it can go on and off.

MEMORY NOTES: 1. SHIRT ("compassion") covers the heart. 2. HAT ("kindness") covers mind: THINK about being kind to people. 3. SOCKS ("humility") sometimes smell! Notice, too, that compassion and kindness (how we feel toward and treat others), come before humility (how we feel about ourselves): if we have humility, we will put others first. 4. SHORTS ("gentleness") have puppy on them: you should be gentle with puppies. 5. It requires "patience" to learn to tie SHOES.

To make a suitcase for boy and his wardrobe, fold a 9" x 12" sheet of construction paper in half, tape or staple along 2 sides, leaving opening in top. Cut out a long rectangle (about 1" x 4") under top edge to make a handle.

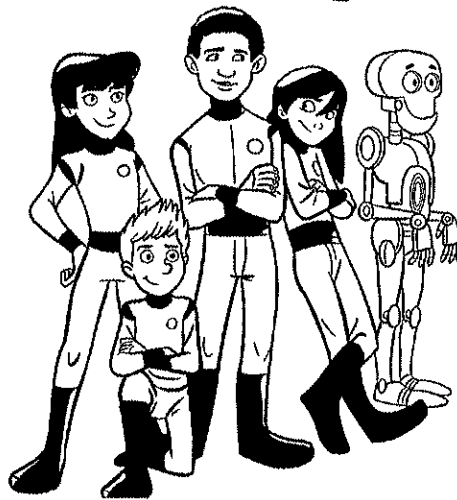
